REGISTRATION BEGINS on Wednesday, June 1, 2011 at both locations.

Online only preregistration begins Monday, May 16, 2011. Readers may enroll in person or online any time during the program through Friday, July 22, 2011, before closing time. Online registration may be completed using the child's library card and pin number by following the link from the Laman Library's homepage at www.lamanlibrary.org. Each participant enrolled will receive a bag, a button, a pencil, a bookmark and a reading log to record the number of books read.

LIBRARY CARDS may be obtained for all participants at the Main Library or at the Argenta Branch. Each child participating in the Summer Reading Program is encouraged to get his or her own card. For more information about obtaining a library card, call the Main Library at 501-758-1720 or the Argenta Branch at 501-687-1061.

A parent or guardian must accompany the child to get a library card.

READERS' names will be displayed on a chart in the library as they receive stickers. Children will be given 1 sticker for every 3 chapters or every picture book read. Throughout the program readers will receive special incentives for chapters read. Top readers in grades 1-12 will receive a ribbon and have a book placed in the library with his/her name in it.

NON-READERS may enroll in the **YOU READ TO ME** program. Small children will also be given a sticker for every 3 chapters or every picture book read to them. The stickers will be displayed on a sheet in the library. Non-readers will also receive special incentives throughout the program.

PARTICIPANTS MAY REPORT to the staff the number of chapters read **ONLY once a day**. There is no limit to online reporting.

LAST DAY TO REPORT : Saturday, July 23 , 2011 before closing time.

PRIZE DRAWINGS will be held weekly for all participants who reported books during that week.

SPECIAL INCENTIVES will be given at the discretion of the library staff.
